The Purpose

Nine-day wildlife and landscape photography Workshop in Svalbard from June 22, 2022 to June 30, 2022.

Governing Law/Jurisdiction

The Workshop Leaders operate in accordance with Italian law and jurisdiction.

Services Included in the Workshop

- Photography Workshop, individual coaching and photography feedback by two experienced professional photographers throughout the programme
- Transfer from/to the airport in Longyearbyen on 22 and 30 June 2022 via bus
- 8 nights in hotel
- Breakfast and Lunch
- Days 2-6: Thermal suit, snacks, hot drinks, rescue insurance, local guide, emergency/safety equipment, pick-up and transport to and from the accommodations
- Comprehensive pre-departure material
- Photography handbook with all the notes covered throughout the Workshop

Services Excluded from the Workshop

- Flights
- Pre- and post-travel arrangements
- Passport and Visa expenses

- Government arrival and departure taxes
- Dinners
- Travel insurance (strongly recommended)
- Excess baggage charges and all items of a personal nature such as laundry, bar, beverage charges and telecommunication charges
- Extra activities, such as visit to the museum
- Anything not mentioned in “Services included in the Workshop”

Workshop Price

- €3600, if booking before or on 31 March 2022
- €4000, if booking after 31 March 2022

Terms of Payment

The accepted payment methods include bank transfer (no additional cost on the Workshop Leaders' behalf) or via Visa/Mastercard (a 1.5% fee may apply). Participants must cover the exchange rates and transfer fees. The transaction is charged in EURO. Final payment is always conducted in EURO. Refunds are also conducted in EURO.

Cancellation Policy and Refunds

PAYMENT POLICY:

- 50% initial deposit to secure the Workshop spot
- 50% final balance by April 22nd, 2022

REFUND POLICY:

- Within 30 days of deposit invoice date: participant receives a 100% refund (minus any transaction fees) should they decide to cancel.
- After 30 days from deposit invoice date: deposits are non-refundable.
- If the participant books less than 60 days before departure: a single payment is required and the Workshop price is non-refundable.

If eligible, refunds will be paid in the same method that the original payment was made. Refunds will be initiated within 72 hours of the time that the request is approved.

CANCELED WORKSHOP:

If there are any complications with traveling or uncertainties arising that may impact the participants close to the Workshop, the Workshop Leaders reserve the right to make the executive decision for the collective safety of all participants in the group. If the Workshop Leaders are forced to cancel the Workshop for any reason, the participant's entire tuition will be transferred to another Workshop or refunded.

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

The Workshop Leaders are not liable for any cost associated with travel, lodging, insurance, health emergencies, equipment rentals or incidental losses incurred in the event of a Workshop cancellation, or if the participant withdraws from the Workshop for any reason.

While the participant is not required to purchase travel insurance, it is strongly recommended. The participants' insurance should include Covid-19 coverage.

If the participant contracts Covid-19 before the departure and is unable to travel, the participant will have to go through their travel insurance company to be covered for any refunds.

UNDER-SUBSCRIPTION: The Workshop requires a minimum number of participants, and will be confirmed once the minimum number is reached. In the event that the Workshop Leaders do not sell out or reach a minimum number of participants, they reserve the right to cancel the Workshop. In this case, a full refund will be given. The Workshop Leaders are not liable for any cost (insurance, flight ticket, camera rental, etc.) the participant might have incurred before the confirmation of the Workshop.

Privacy Policy

The Workshop Leaders respect the participant's privacy and do not tolerate spam. The Workshop Leaders will never sell, rent, lease or give away the participant's information (name, address, e-mail, phone number) to a third party. When the participant signs up for the Workshop via the Workshop Leaders' website, or communicates with the Workshop Leaders, the participant is opted in to our newsletter and communication. If the participant would like to unsubscribe, they may do so at the bottom of an email with the click of a button.

The participant is granted a non-exclusive, limited-use license of this material. Other Information

- The Workshop Leaders reserve the right to take photographs or videos during the operation of any expedition or part thereof and to use the resulting photography for promotional purposes. By making a reservation with the Workshop Leaders, participants agree to allow their images to be used in such photography; participants who prefer that their image not be used are asked to identify themselves to the Workshop Leaders at the commencement of their trip.
- The tour is always dependent on weather, as the weather can be highly unpredictable in the Arctic.
- The Workshop Leaders cannot be liable to any loss, damage, accidents, injuries or sickness during the tour. The same applies for any changes in tour schedule due to weather, strikes or any other force majeure. The Workshop Leaders reserve the right to

change routes, schedules and itineraries if needed because of weather, road, and/or boat route conditions or should the necessity arise because of unforeseen reasons. It is advised for all participants to purchase comprehensive travel insurance to minimize possible losses due to unforeseeable situations during their travel.

- The participant acknowledges that this Workshop will require walking on Arctic terrain and in subzero temperatures. The participant should be of general good health. The participant must inform the Workshop Leaders of any severe health conditions that may impact their ability to participate in a planned tour.
- The participant must bring the minimum required photographic equipment, mentioned in the gear list in order to assure a successful participation in the Workshop.
- Before the participant starts the tour, the participant should make sure to have email contact with the Workshop Leaders.
- If the participant has any complaints or comments, the participant can let the Workshop Leaders know as soon as possible via email. The Workshop Leaders value all comments and will try to better themselves where needed.
- This document is final. There are no additional agreements. Verbal agreements, declarations, promises, and guarantees concerning the Workshop shall only become effective in writing.
